Would you like to learn more about becoming a UC Master Gardener? The University of California Master Gardeners in San Luis Obispo County is hosting an informal information session.

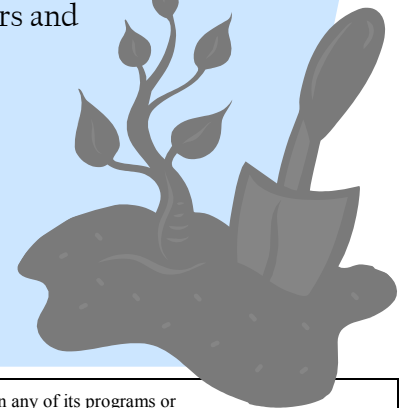
There will be experienced Master Gardeners present to answer all of your questions about the Master Gardener Training program and describe the volunteer commitment.
