Grafted Brandywine - One pound wonder. A great Heirloom now on vigorous & disease resistant rootstock – the perfect tomato!

Tomaccio - The sweet raisin tomato - oh so sweet! Something new!

Red Tomatoes

Amish Paste - Heirloom, my favorite paste Tomato - 8 oz.

Applause - VFFA - This hybrid is delicious and disease resistant. Grows well in a container.

Ball's Beefsteak - VFFT - Big tomato with old fashion flavor.

Beefmaster - VFN - Up to 2 pounds (!) with great flavor.

Big Beef - VFFNTA - My favorite red hybrid 8 - 12 oz.

Cosmonaut Volkov - One of my favorite red heirlooms; Russian.

Costoluto Genovese - Beautiful big red fluted Italian Heirloom.

Goose Creek - An heirloom brought to us by Caribbean slaves.

Jet Star - VF - One of the few low acid tomatoes; do not can without adding lemon juice.

Lenor - Commercial red medium size; grows well in a container.

Love Apple - Heirloom as good as Brandywine, 3" pink tomato.

Marianna's Peace - Home town Radio MG Robin's favorite heirloom.

Matina - My favorite very early tomato; small with big flavor.

Mr. Brown's - Large pink heirloom you'll only find here.

Porter - A 4 oz plum shaped tomato good for canning, flavorful

Royesta - F1 & F2, N, TMV - Disease resistant and tasty, 6 - 8 oz.

Soldaki - Large dense & meaty heirloom from Poland.

Stupice - A very early cold - tolerant tomato from Czechoslovakia.

Victoria Supreme - VFFNA - Large & meaty paste tomato. Grows well in a container.

Non-Red Tomatoes

Berkeley Tie Dye - One of my favorite multi-colored tomatoes.

Black from Tula - Deep reddish-brown beefsteak; delicious.

Black Plum - 3" plum or paste tomato, sweet and tangy.

Carbon - One of the darkest & the best of the black tomatoes.

Cherokee Chocolate - Wonderful flavor; can weigh up to a pound.

Golden Girl - VFNTA - My favorite hybrid orange tomato.

Green Zebra - Green & amber, sweet & zingy; my favorite green tomato.

Jaune Flamme - Small orange with red insides, big taste!

Lemon Boy - VFN - My favorite hybrid yellow, yum!

Pineapple - My favorite bi-colored tomato; you'll love it!

Plum Lemon - It looks like a lemon but is a tasty tomato.

Purple Russian - Plum or paste shaped; beautiful and productive.

Southern Night - My favorite black heirloom. Grows well in a container.

Tasty Evergreen - Greenish-yellow medium large heirloom.

Virginia Sweets - Super sweet and meaty, bi-color.

White Giant - Creamy white large sweet tomato.

Yellow Pear - A real cutie; not a real cherry tomato, but almost!

Cherry Tomatoes

If tomatoes have not done well in your garden, try cherry tomatoes, they are hardy and prolific. They make terrific sauce and are great right out of the garden.

Green Grape - Looks like an olive, tastes like a tomato.

Sweet Baby Girl - Yummy red cherries on compact plants. Grows well in a container.

Sun Gold - Everyone's favorite; wins the taste test every year!
