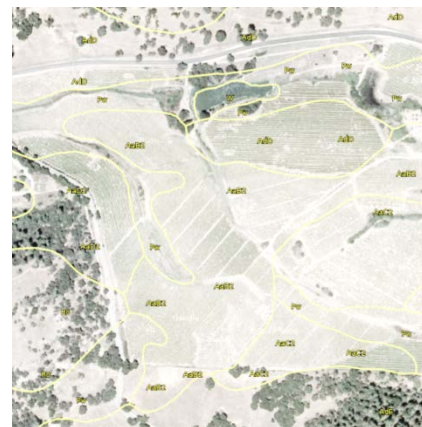

We will explore several soil pits dug on a as yet unplanted vineyard site adjacent to existing Boeger vineyards –a Boomer- Sites metalvolcanic/metasedimentary soil, by viewing soil pits and discussing the effects of the soils on vineyard management.
