

Story Retell Sheet Narrative Book

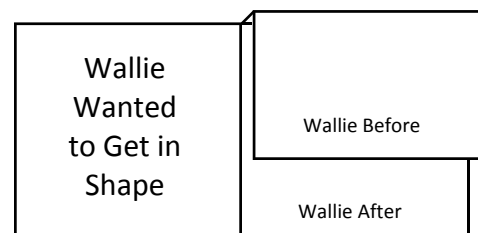
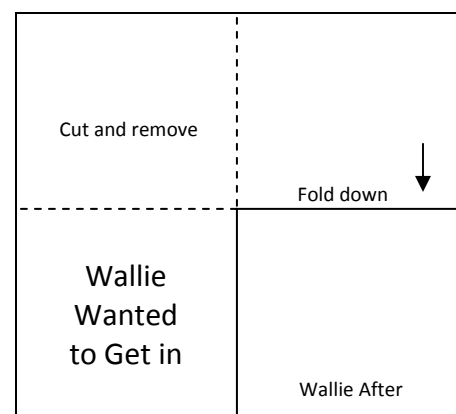
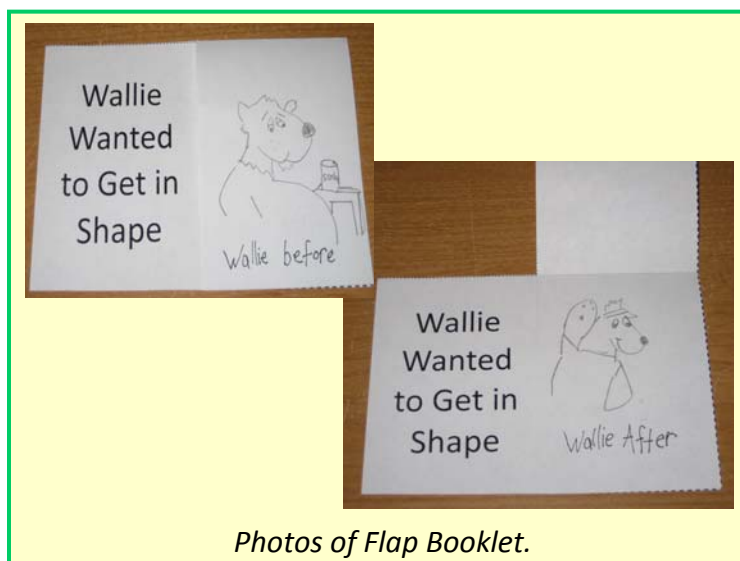
Wallie Exercises

Supplies:

- Copy of the sheet on page 16, one for each child
- Scissor for each child
- Markers, crayons, or pencils

Instructions for Assembling the Booklet:

1. Cut out the pattern found on page 16. Fold the paper in half, and then half again so it creates four sections.
2. Open the paper and cut off the upper left section.
3. On the left side of the flap are the words - *Wallie Wanted to Get in Shape*.
4. Fold the top right flap down and have the students write *Wallie Before* at the bottom of the flap. Ask them to draw a picture on the flap of Wallie at the beginning of the story.
5. Open up the flap and on the bottom right side, have the students write *Wallie After* on the bottom of the flap. Ask them to draw a picture of Wallie at the end of the story.
6. Ask several of the students share their booklets.
