Welcome to the 2014 Stanislaus County Youth Poultry Show in Modesto, CA. We look forward to hosting an absolutely fun show with top-notch events for the youth to enjoy all day long. This year we have moved to our new exciting location! Modesto Junior College inside of the new huge "ACE" pavilion.

Let us refresh you on how last year went. This was our fourth shot at hosting a poultry show and WOW was it fun! With almost 700 birds entered into the show and over 100 exhibitors (all youth) you might say it was a huge success for a youth show. The crowds flocked into the building all day long to see the beautiful birds on exhibit along with the outstanding showmanship competition that took place.

Modesto Junior College did a fabulous job assisting us with the youth activities like Knowledge Quiz, Poster Contest, Photo Contest, Poultry Judging, and the always popular Poultry Obstacle course. The Showmanship competition was loaded with talent with over 110 entries. As far as the exhibits went, the judges were amazed at the high quality of birds entered with a Champions Row that boasted quality from one end to the other. Hardware and Ribbons galore were presented throughout the day along with cash prizes. Kids were carrying gift baskets stuffed with poultry supplies (Books, Feeders, Waterers, Vet RX, Feed, Electrolytes, etc?) and looked like they needed wheelbarrows to get them out to the vehicle. Keeping everyone's taste buds satisfied, the food booth had great snacks and a scrumptious lunch for all to enjoy that day and even biscuits and gravy for breakfast. JS West Feed Store also had their full line of poultry products on display and available that day for purchase at their vendor booth which was busy from start to finish. You also may have encountered a full size chicken mascot free ranging around taking photo ops with everyone all day too.

Again this year we are honored to provide a special award, that comes with a huge perpetual trophy and a \$200 cash prize for the winner, along with awards for second and third also, it is called the Lowell Sherman award. This award is given to the person who accumulates the most points throughout the day. Points are earned by participating in each competition and also how well you place in that contest. In addition points are earned for the birds you exhibit also. We have placed caps on the maximum amount of points you can earn in each area, so as to make it as fair as possible to all competitors. Ultimately the goal should be award to individuals who are well rounded and most successful overall throughout the day. Which means "participate in everything!!!" This award can only be won one time, then you are no longer eligible in the future.

Our show is a youth only show for ages 5-18 and we look to cater to these young folks all day long. But just because you don't fall into this age group doesn't mean you can't come by and enjoy the day and support the youth of our hobby.

This year, we are proud to announce we have secured both judges for the exhibition birds. First is Dave Anderson from California who we are excited to have as a part of our show, and second is Paul Kroll flying in all the way from New York.

In conclusion we would like to say we understand that with all the above mentioned activities it will make for a busy day in which individuals will have to pick and choose what they want to participate in. This format will better assist us in determining which topics and events draw the most interest and participation in order to better serve you in the future. ## Youth Activities Rules

### Photo Contest Rules

- \*All photos should be poultry related
- \*Photos must have been taken by contestant
- \*Contestants name and age MUST be on BACK of photo
- \*Awards will be given for each age group (5-8 / 9-11/ 12-13 / 14-18)

### Poultry Judging

- \*A class of exhibition poultry will be on display for contestants to judge between 8am - 2pm
- \*The class will then be judged by APA/ABA Judge and results will be given and explained
- \*Awards will be given for each age group (5-8 / 9-11 / 12-13 / 14 -18)

### Knowledge Quiz

- \*A poultry based general knowledge quiz will be available to take between 8am - 2pm
- \*Awards will be given for each age group (5-8 / 9-11 / 12-13 / 14 -18)

### Poster Contest

- \*All posters must have been made by contestant
- \*Categories are Educational, My chicken,
- \*Contestants name and age MUST be on BACK of poster
- \*Awards will be given for each age group (5-8 / 9-11/ 12-13 / 14-18)

### Obstacle Course

- \*Each contestant will bring their bird to the start line and begin once the judge says go. The contestant will lead the bird through the course with either a show stick or a treat or both while being timed. If a bird flies forward or off the table it must be placed back at it's place of exit and then continue from there.
- \*Awards will be given for the fastest times.

## Stanislaus County Youth Poultry Show Rules

1. Entries must be postmarked by March 3, 2014
2. All entries received in the showroom must be leg-banded
3. Any bird showing evidence of infectious or contagious disease will be removed from the showroom and isolated.
4. Each exhibitor will be responsible for feeding and watering their birds.
5. SCYPS will not be responsible for theft, loss or accidents to exhibits.
6. Judging will be by comparison with the latest edition of the APA and ABA Standard of Perfection.
7. No early coop-outs unless prior arrangements have been made.
8. Please check coop cards for accuracy before the show begins.
