RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY: MIXED CROP-LIVESTOCK FARMS

Seeking volunteers for a study accessing the dynamics of foodborne pathogens (i.e., *Campylobacter* spp.) in integrated mixed crop-livestock systems involving multiple livestock species.
