RESEARCH PRE-PROPOSAL CONTENT AND FORMAT GUIDELINES

Revised 9/2017

Pre-proposals be submitted in Word format, 11 point Times New Roman font. Do not include page numbers, headers or footers. Margins: 1.25" left margin; 1" right, top and bottom margin. Length of pre-proposal not to exceed one page.

REQUIRED PRE-PROPOSAL ELEMENTS

PROJECT TITLE: Limited to 70 characters including spaces. If funded, this title must stay the same throughout the life of the project.

PROPOSED DURATION: State anticipated duration of the project. Select 1, 2 or 3 years. Maximum length is 3 years.

PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR(s): Name, institutional affiliations, telephone and email contact information for each PI and Co-PI.

BUDGET: Estimated amount to be requested for each year of project

JUSTIFICATION: Provide a concise summary how this research project will benefit California cherry growers.

OBJECTIVES: Using numbering system (1, 2, 3....) identify the specific objectives set forth in the research proposal.
