

TENTATIVE LIVESTOCK SCHEDULE

(Subject to Change - Dependent upon number of Entries per Species)

NEW CHANGES TO LIVESTOCK SCHEDULE BELOW!!

1. **Market & Breeding Swine arrive Tuesday, June 5th between 1 pm – 6 pm.**
2. **Hog scales open Tuesday, June 5th between 6:30 pm – 8:30 pm. All Market Hogs must be weighed Tuesday, June 5th 2018!**
3. **Poultry Inspection and weigh-in will be Tuesday, June 5th from 4 pm – 8 pm during poultry check-in.**
4. **Poultry arrive Tuesday, June 5th between 4 pm – 8 pm. No other species are allowed to arrive on grounds before Wednesday, June 6th at 7 am**
5. **Market Animals accepted Wednesday, June 6th between 7 am – 3 pm. Exception to swine.**
6. **All Market Animals must be on fairgrounds by 3 pm on Wednesday, June 6th. Weigh-in ENDS at 3:30 pm.**
7. **Breeding Swine, Breeding Sheep and Breeding Goats accepted Wednesday from 7 am until 3:30 pm. Breeding Dairy Animals including Replacement Heifers and Breeding Beef must be on grounds by 3:30 pm.**
8. **Rabbit Check-In, Inspection and Weigh-In starts at 8 am. Rabbit Show and Showmanship begins at 9 am.**
9. **REPLACEMENT HEIFERS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 3:00 pm. Inspection will begin at 2 pm in the Dairy Ring. All Replacement Heifers must be inspected by 4pm. Brand papers must be present during the inspection.**
10. **Scale and weigh-in times have changed! Tuesday and Wednesday schedules below for designated weigh-in times!**
11. **Selection of Supreme Champions moved to Thursday June 7th at 8 pm.**
12. **All Night Hawks must be off fairgrounds by 7 am and must be over the age of 21. (see rule 24 above)**
13. **Awards Ceremony moved to Sunday June 10th, 2018 at 5 pm.**
14. **NO ANIMALS ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED ARRIVAL TIMES! ALL EXHIBITORS WILL BE TURNED AWAY PRIOR TO DESIGNATED TIME.**
15. **NEW!: All Livestock exhibitors must be invoice runners during the Market Auction on Saturday June 9th, 2018. A runner schedule will be posted Friday before the Dairy Replacement Auction. The schedule will be broken into times slots and assigned to clubs/chapters/independents. Time slot size will be determined by number of exhibitors per club/chapter/independent. If any club/chapter doesn't show up to their assigned time slot there will be a penalty determined by Fair Manager.**

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6th

Wednesday Scale Schedule:

Sheep will begin at 1:30 pm. All sheep and goats must be weighed by 3:30 pm. Health inspections will be completed at the time of weigh-in.

Goat weigh-in to follow sheep. All sheep and goats must be weighed by 3:30 pm. Health inspections will be completed at the time of weigh-in.

Beef inspection and weigh-in begins at 1:30 pm. All beef must be weighed by 3 pm. Brand inspections and transportation slip must be presented at the time of weigh-in.

Replacement Heifers and Yearlings Check-in will begin at 2:30 pm. Check-in ends at 4 pm.

Breeding Swine, Breeding Sheep and Breeding Goats accepted Wednesday from 7 am until 3:30 pm. Breeding

Dairy Animals including Replacement Heifers and Breeding Beef must be on grounds by 3:30 pm.

All Market Animals must be on fairgrounds by 3 pm on Wednesday, June 6th for weigh-in.

Rabbit Weigh-In at 8 am and Rabbit Show and Showmanship at 9 am. (See Rabbit handbook for more info.)
