



## Dog Showmanship Supplemental Video Instructions for June 2020 San Mateo County 4-H Virtual Livestock Show

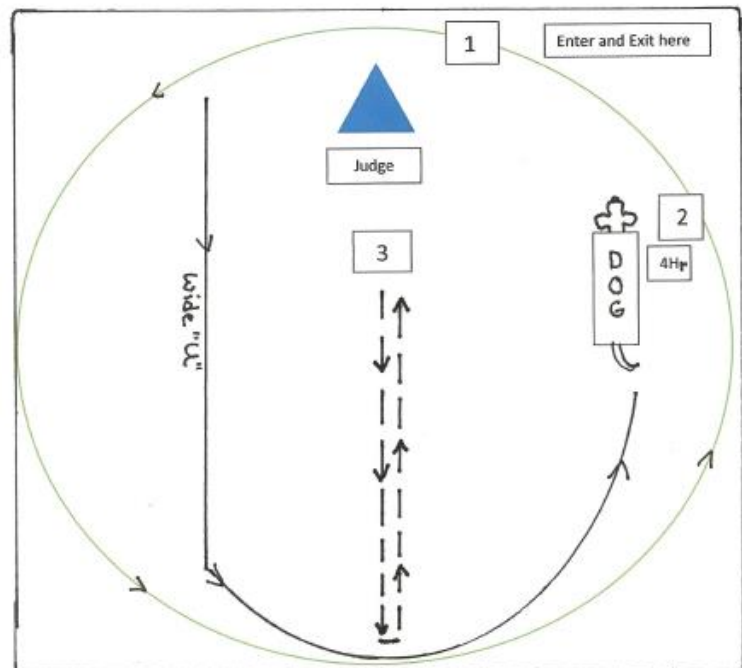
This is your opportunity to demonstrate your knowledge and skills in presenting and moving your dog. Please refer to the general video requirements provided by Virtual Show Stock: <https://ucanr.edu/sites/smsf4h/files/327570.pdf>

You will be scored on your dog's appearance and handling.

The pattern we would like to see:

1. Make a circle away from the "judge" represented by a chair or something similar, returning and stacking the dog about 5 feet to the right of the "judge."
2. Pose the dog. Show the dog at attention-may use a treat. Point to a part of the dog's front or rear leg and name the part.
3. Straight down and back stopping and stacking with the dog 3-4 feet in front of the "judge."

1. Circle (or wide "U"), 2. Pose, 3. Down and Back

At the end, please tell the "judge" the breed and which AKC group the dog is in (i.e., herding, sporting, etc.) For mixed dogs do your best guess and pick one of the breeds.

As a reminder, do not state your name, club, breeder or any details about your project in the video.

Your video should be no longer than 2 minutes.
