USDA has declared a drought disaster for Placer, Nevada, Sutter, and Yuba Counties. Through the Farm Service Agency (FSA), ranchers may be eligible for assistance and/or emergency loan programs. In addition, the Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) has a variety of cost share programs that may help producers cope with drought impacts.
