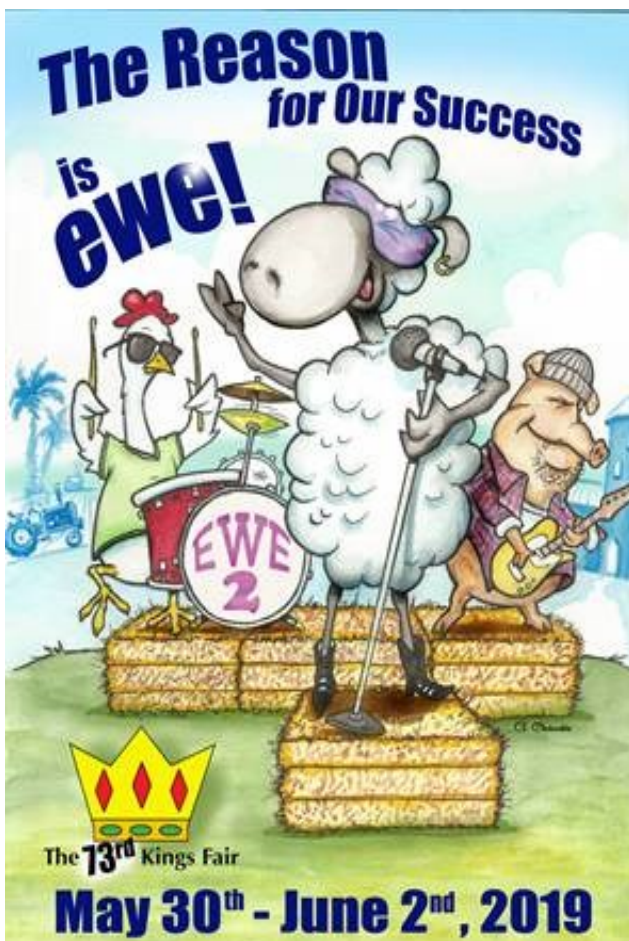

As an ambassador my goal is to reach out into the public and inform people that 4-H is not just about showing livestock. It is learning life skills and so much more.

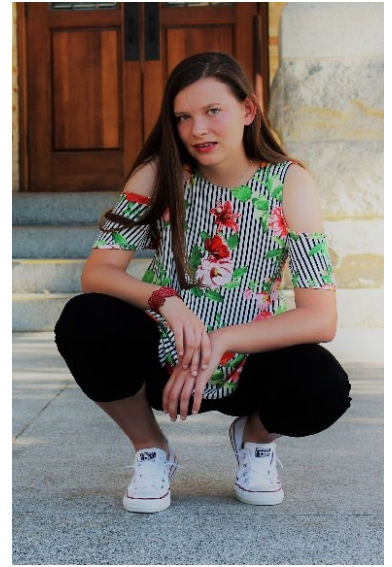
