

Important Meetings on Water

Participants in MWD's Interim Agricultural Water Program (IAWP) and / or growers in the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board's (SD WQCB) jurisdiction should attend. The MWD Board has approved a negotiated phase-out of the IAWP. Now it's important for growers to decide the best option for their particular situation. Does your grove situation warrant an immediate opt-out of the program in exchange for increased supply reliability? Or should you remain in the program until it phases out? Come hear the details of the phase-out options from the experts.

Also, all growers in the SD WQCB region need to be aware of new regulations concerning runoff of stormwater, sediment, irrigation, or other waste from farms. These regulations effect every grower in San Diego County:
