Divisions:

- ◆ Junior: participants ages 9-13 years old as of December 31, 2015.
- ◆ Senior: participants ages 14-19 years old as of December 31, 2015.
- ◆ Novice: participant who has never loped in any show (open, 4-H, breed, gymkhana, schooling, etc.) and meets one of the following criteria: first or second year showing under saddle (does not include lead line) at any show, **OR** first year in a 4-H horse project and is either 9 or 10 years old as of December 31, 2015.

Classes:

- ◆ All riders must wear a helmet that meets ASTM/SEI standards while mounted at all times.
- ◆ The 4-H Uniform is appropriate for all events: riding boots, white collared shirt, jeans (white or dark blue), and 4-H scarf or tie.
- ◆ Top three (3) riders in each class will qualify to go on to the 4-H State Horse Classic and State Fair.
- ◆ Classes with less than three (3) riders may be combined or cancelled.
- ◆ Ribbons will be awarded top three (3) in each class.
- ◆ Buckles will be awarded to High Point Novice, Junior, and Senior.

Event Courtesies:

- ◆ Parents/ Project Leaders will supervise their members and their mounts at all times.
- ◆ Dogs and pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
