



## Placer County 4-H Youth Development Program 4-H Council Selection Committee Job Description

### General Description

The Council Selection Committee is a volunteer committee working in cooperation with the county 4-H Office and the Placer County 4-H Council. The Council Selection Committee is responsible for reviewing applications for council positions and making recommendations for position appointment.

### Committee Member Responsibilities:

The Council Selection Committee will:

- Identify Placer County 4-H volunteers that could serve on the council
- Personally invite volunteers to apply for a position on the council
- Review applications
- Decide on final candidates
- Recommend a slate of officers to the council

### Term of Appointment

The Council Selection Committee shall serve a one-year term with eligibility to apply for reappointment to another term.
