 - a. Personal Development Report (PDR): Youth, parent and 4-H Adult Partner (project leader) sign this report once it is completed by the youth member.
 - b. Annual Project Report (APR): Youth and 4-H Adult Partner (project leader) sign this report.
 - c. Leadership Development Report (LDR): Youth and 4-H Adult Partner (project leader) sign this report.
3. Attend **PROJECT MEETINGS**, with a minimum participation of 6-project hours.
