- 3. Plan to continue your education at a college or trade or technical school.**

- 1. Official copy of your high school transcript**
- 2. One letter of recommendation from either an FFA Advisor or a 4-H leader**
- 3. HANDWRITTEN (not typed) letter of intent (250-500 word essay) that includes the following:**
  - a. Short biography about yourself**
  - b. Immediate and long-term goals, (education, career and personal)**
  - c. Financial need, if any**
  - d. Answer the following prompt...**
