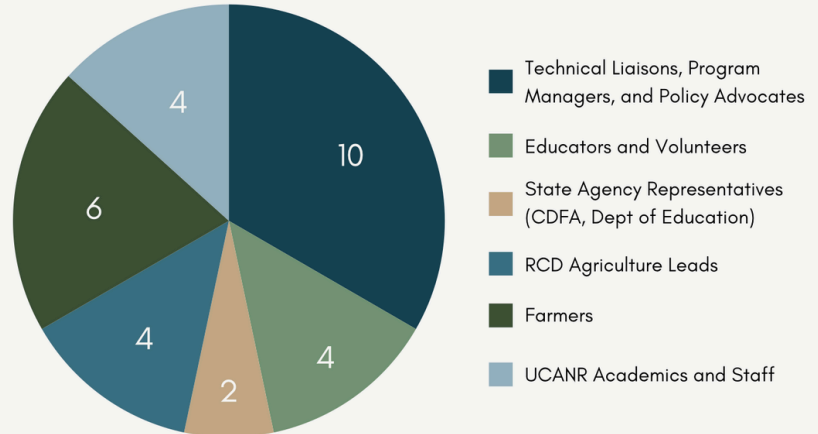
GROWING CONNECTIONS IN SAN BERNARDINO

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The two growers we visited did not face major land access issues, but struggle more with management, production, and distribution systems.
- Old Grove Orange uses agrotourism and youth outreach to build community engagement and increase farm visibility.
 - This is something that Jehovah Jireh Mobile Farm would like to grow into as well.
- Top crops: citrus, avocados, corn, and strawberries.

CHALLENGES

- Additional support needed with buying and maintaining equipment and resources.
- Growers need more support with larger pest management - donkeys are a local issue.
- Land tenure leases span up to 5 years but do not provide enough long-term stability.
- County-level policies often prioritize infrastructure and development over agriculture, overlooking its role as a community need.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- **Incentivize land match** and succession programs statewide (i.e. offer an open & no-cost platform for landholders and land seekers)
- **Recognize agriculture as essential infrastructure** in county planning to secure long-term viability of urban-edge and peri-urban farms.
- **Incentivize local governments** to integrate small farms and agrotourism into economic development plans.
- **Support farmer training** and technical assistance focused on distribution, business development, and marketing.
