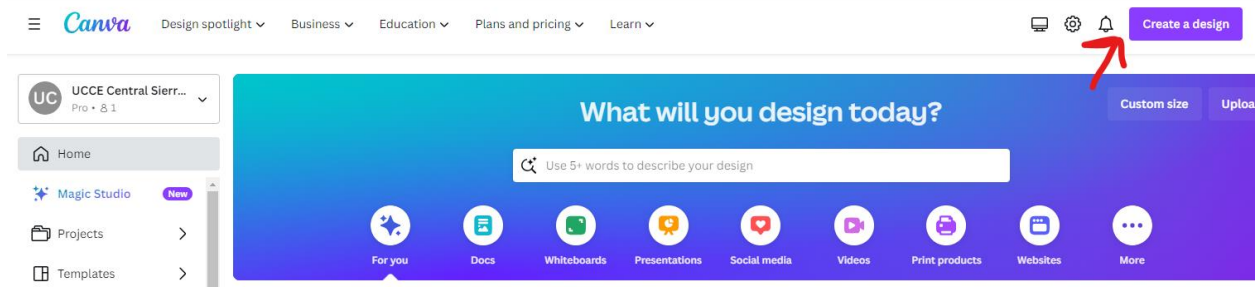


# Creating Custom QR Codes in *Canva*

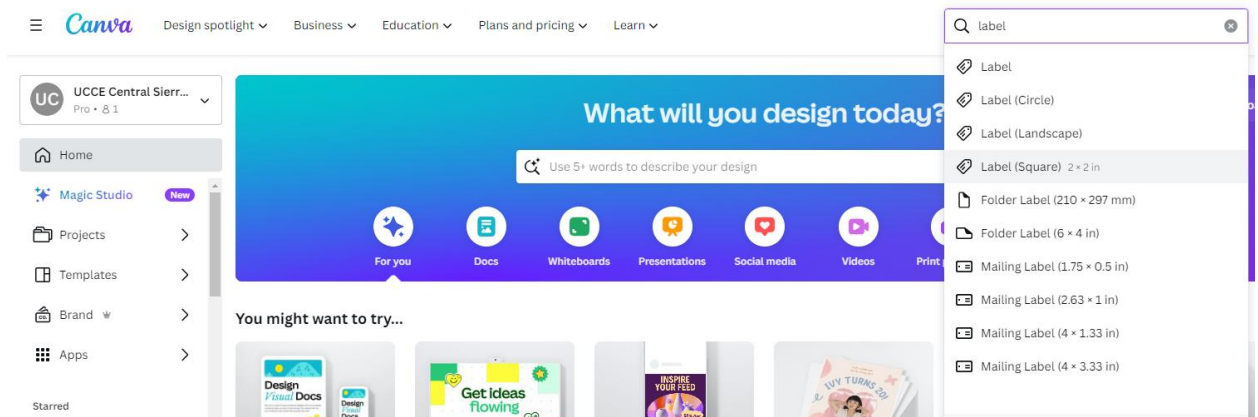
## 1. Login/Create a Canva Account -- the free version is sufficient!

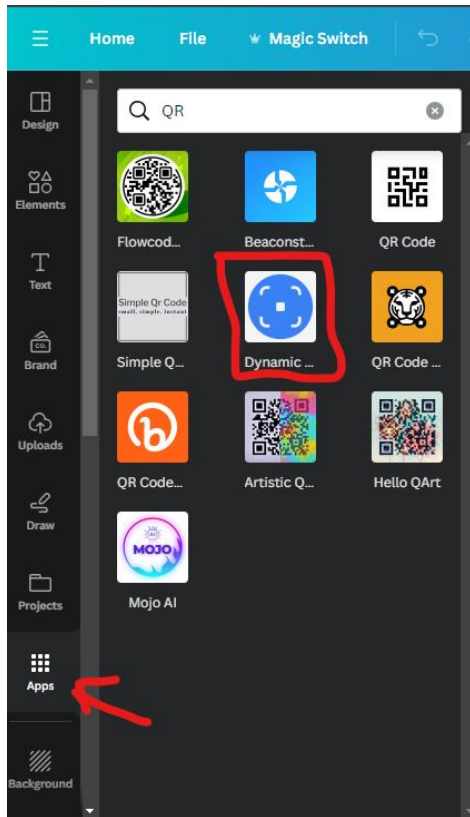
## 2. Select the “Create a design” tab



## 3. Search for “label” and select Label (Square) 2 x 2 in



- From the side menu select the “Apps” tab and search “QR”. Click on Dynamic QR.














- Select your preferred template



- Add your link, choose QR code color, background color and upload a logo if desired. You may also select a pattern to change the aesthetic.

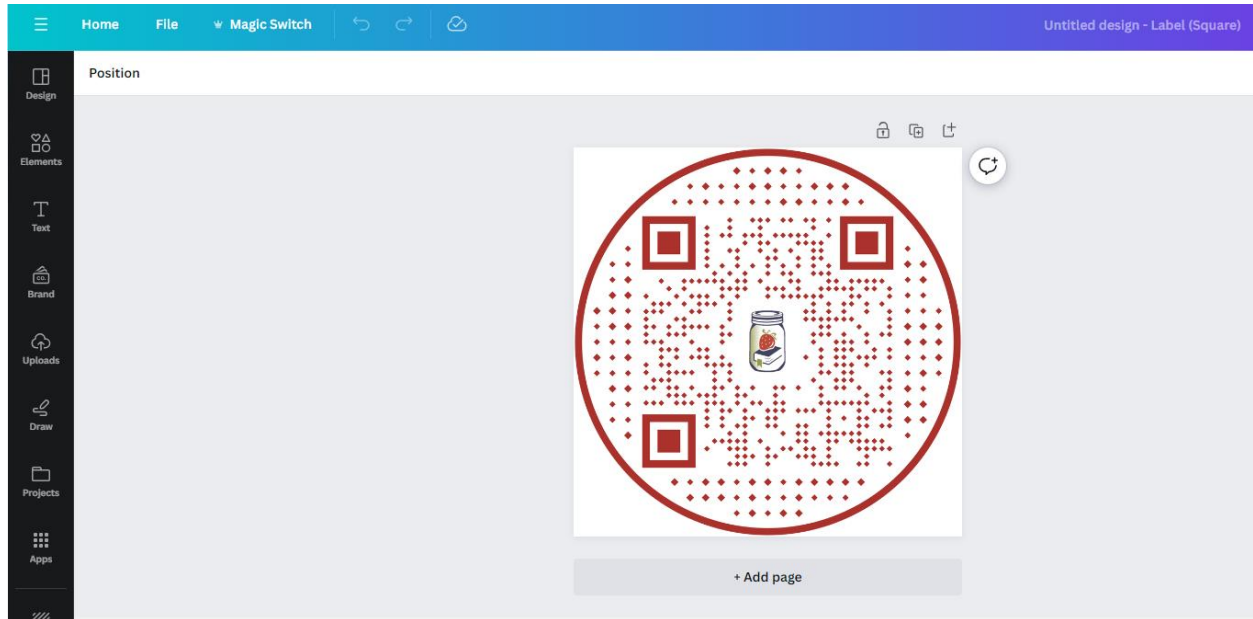
(Click on the image, the right-click and and select

“Save Image As...” to save to your computer:

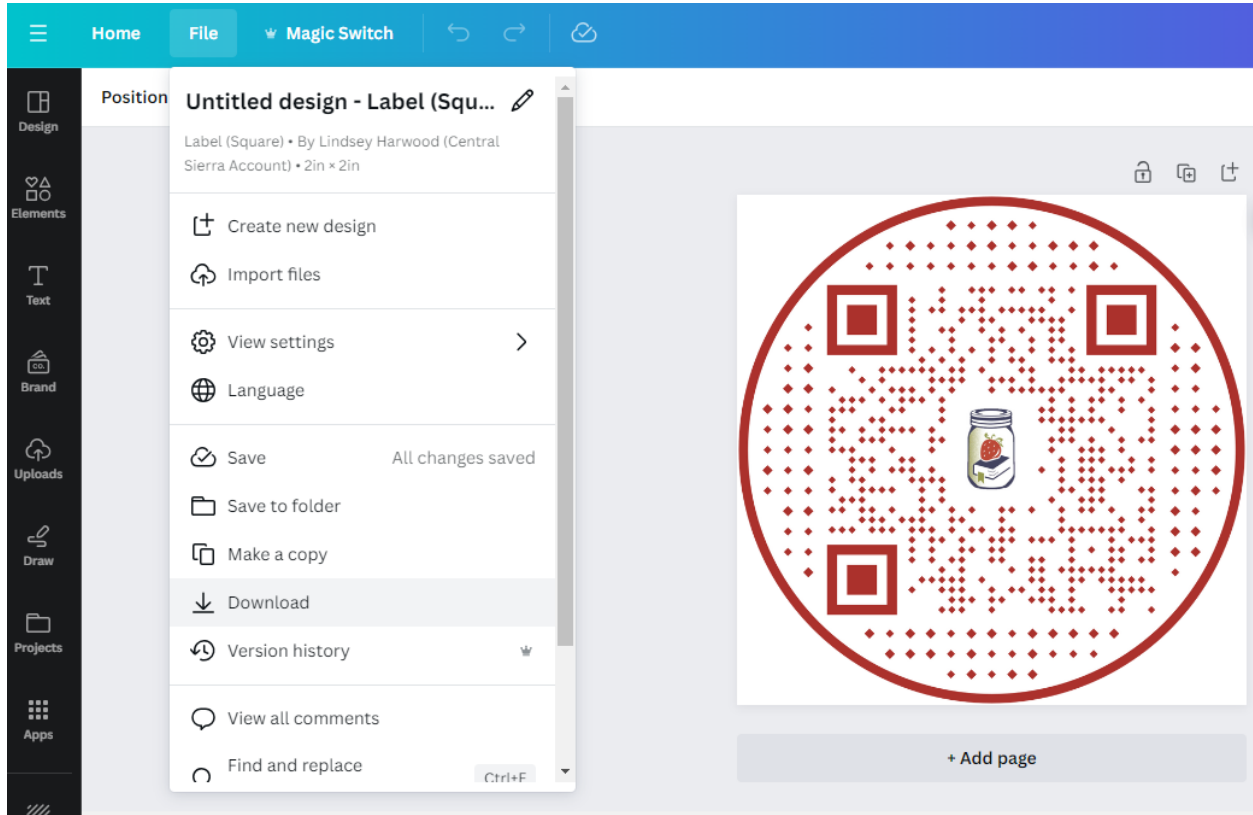


7. Click “Add to design” (do not check the “Dynamic” box, this is a fee-based option that tracks clicks). Resize the QR code to fit the square.

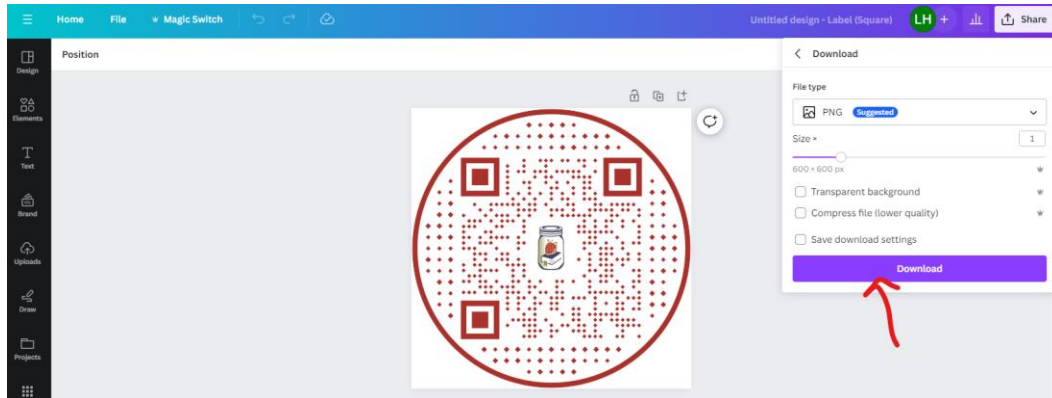
**TEST THE QR CODE!** Take out your phone and test to make sure the link is correct.



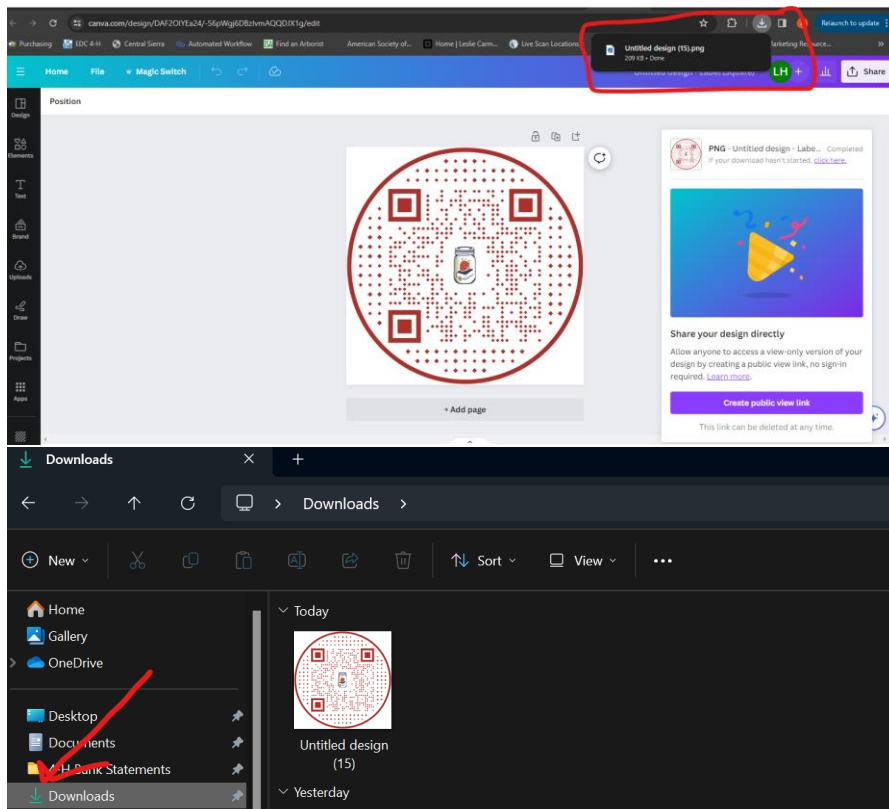
8. From the top menu select File > Download



## 9. Confirm the file type (it defaults to PNG) and click Download



## 10. The file will be downloaded, and you can click the download icon on your browser to open the file, or find in your computer's download folder



## 11. Be sure to rename your file (in your computer files and/or in Canva) so that you know what the QR code is for. Enjoy using QR codes to promote your classes and events, and direct people to your websites! 😊
