- **Secretary's Report/Minutes** – on a motion by Lara Felipe and seconded Stephanie Fry, the minutes were approved as printed.
- **Treasurers Report** – was tabled in the absence of Treasurer Lilly Pimentel
- **Reports** –
 - 4-H Staff Report – Cayci Hill has returned to work and discussed the need for training for new and returning leaders. On a motion by Lara Felipe, seconded by Melanie Curtis, Council approved to fund dinner for leaders who attend leaders training on August 16, 2024. Training will be held beginning at 6:00 p.m. and will be followed by Leaders Council meeting.
