



It is that time again, applications for the Devil's Garden Colt Challenge are open! The Devil's Garden Colt Challenge is an opportunity for youth to take home and train a wild horse. Horses are typically weanlings but older horses can be made available for experienced 4-Hers. Youth trainers are given a 6 month training window and an opportunity to compete at the Colt Challenge which is held at the Modoc District Fair in August. The top trainer receives \$1000 cash. There are over \$3500 in prizes total. Youth can view and pick up horses in Alturas, Litchfield and Ridgecrest, CA.
