



2026 PLUMAS-SIERRA CATTLEMEN ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION-QUALIFICATIONS

At the discretion of P-S Cattlemen's Association, two (2) scholarships will be awarded, one to a graduating senior and one to a continuing college student.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Preference given to applicants whose family derives a major portion of their income from agriculture (does not have to be pursuing a career in agriculture); or
Applicant from a non-farm or ranching family enrolling in a course of study relating to agriculture.
- B. Applicant must be a resident of Plumas or Sierra County for at least one year at the time of application, or a current college student who lived in Plumas or Sierra County during high school.
- C. Applicant must be a graduating senior of a Plumas or Sierra County school. Charter schools are included. Applications will be accepted during senior year, or
Applicant may be a college student that previously applied for one of P-S Cattlemen's Scholarships (whether or not they were awarded a scholarship).
- D. The applicant must have demonstrated high moral character, good citizenship and dedication to American ideals.
- E. The applicant shall have a cumulative 2.5 grade point average at time of application.
Applicants must enroll in the fall as a full-time student at a 2-year college, 4-year college, or trade school.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Transcript** with high school grades and/or college transcripts (unofficial records are acceptable).
2. **Completed scholarship application form** (see next page).
3. **Resume/Activity List/CV** with school activities, other extra-curricular activities, work experiences (including on family ranch), volunteer projects, etc. Please include honors received and offices held. (no more than 4 pages)
4. **Picture** of applicant that the organization is allowed to use for public promotion, if awarded a scholarship.
5. **Autobiography** describing your future career goals, why you chose agriculture as your ambition, and how this scholarship will benefit you. (1 page limit)
6. **Submit TWO signed letters of recommendation** from people other than the applicant's family, giving information about the applicant's character, ability, and career goals. Letters must be submitted with application.
7. May be required to appear for a personal or zoom interview with the Scholarship Committee which will be during April or May of the current year.

If awarded a scholarship, the funds will be available upon providing proof of enrollment of first quarter/semester. **Must submit documentation by December 15, 2026 to receive payment.** Any student who defers college may be ineligible to receive scholarship, this is based solely at the discretion of PS Cattlemen
