

STANISLAUS COUNTY 4-H CLUB COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

Application due by March 31, 2026, not later than 4 p.m.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a senior in high school & plan to graduate in the year in which you apply.
- Must plan a post high school education program – college, trade school, etc.
- Must be a 4-H member for at least 3 years at the time of applying.
- Must be currently enrolled in the Stanislaus County 4-H Youth Development Program as an active member.
- Application must be received at the 4-H County office by the due date.

Application process:

- Complete the application packet
- Provide two (2) letters of recommendation
- Must attend an interview for Scholarship Applicants.

Application Packet – must be bound in a binder in the following order:

1. Application form first (attached)
2. Recommendation letters – two (2) required
 - * A 4-H leader other than parent
 - * Another adult (school counselor, teacher, leader, neighbor, etc.)
3. 4-H Activities Form (attached). Use only space provided on this form, do not add pages.
4. 4-H Story –
 - * Four to six pages, typed, double spaced, font size 12-14.
 - * The 4-H story should expand on your experiences in leadership, citizenship, and community service in 4-H and beyond. Emphasize accomplishments and personal growth in your 4-H work and other experiences.

Interview – After submitting the application, candidates will be scheduled for an interview with the Scholarship Evaluation committee. They should be prepared to discuss important experiences in 4-H, relating personal growth in project knowledge and performance, leadership, citizenship, and plans and goals for the future.
