UCCE Ag. Economics advisor, Domena Agyeman will present on how to evaluate orchard management changes. He will cover how to use partial budgeting to assess the costs and benefits of alternative management practices, including changes in fertilizer and pest management programs and thinning practices, to support decision making. He will also discuss other farm business analysis tools and when to use them to evaluate orchard management decisions.
